## GLOMIS is opened on the Web http://www.glomis.com

GLOMIS was officially opened on the web on 2 March 2001, with the first 3,000 data entries collected on mangrove-related Institutions, People, Projects, and References.

#### Launching ceremonies of GLOMIS

Opening of GLOMIS was marked by two ceremonies. The official launching ceremony was held at the University of the Ryukyus, Okinawa, Japan. Representatives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan, representatives of International Tropical Timber Organizations (ITTO), Government of Okinawa, University of the Ryukyus, ISME Executive Committee, Project Coordinator, Members of the Board of GLOMIS, Leaders and representatives of the Regional Centres attended it. A real-time net communication was made with Laboratoire d'Ecologie Terrestre in Toulouse, France.

Prior to the Official launching ceremony, a Round Table Discussion "What GLOMIS is and what it can do", was held at a hotel in Naha, Okinawa, Japan where a panel of Experts discussed the importance of GLOMIS. The local community and university students interested in mangrove ecosystems participated actively in the ceremony. Local news stations and newspapers reported the events of the ceremony.

The Assistant Coordinator Dr. Mami Kainuma, a microbiologist, who is stationed at the GLOMIS Headquarters in Okinawa, assists the Project Coordinator.
